We are looking for South Asian women living in the United States who are **NOT** currently pregnant **AND** **have a history of gestational diabetes.**

The overall goal of this project is to better understand what types of programs would help women with gestational diabetes. **Please read the email below, complete the anonymous survey (does not take longer than 10-15 minutes), and forward it to every single South Asian woman you know that has had gestational diabetes.** This is the first survey of this magnitude in the United States---your input will help guide programmatic, advocacy and policy efforts---be a part of this!

Please note the South Asian population includes individuals from the following countries (Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, the Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka). The community includes additional members of the South Asian Diaspora, including past generations of South Asians who originally settled in many areas around the world: the Caribbean (Guyana, Jamaica, Suriname, and Trinidad & Tobago); Africa; Canada; Europe; and other parts of Asia and the Pacific Islands.
